

Onion Sets

Onion sets are grown for scallions (green onions) or smaller onions for keeping. Provide, loose, well drained soil and add an inch of water a week, either by rain or by sprinkling.

Plant sets 3 to 4 weeks before the average frost-free date (May 10) in full sun. Plant the sets root end down, about 1" deep. If you want larger onions for fall harvest, the soil should be very shallow on the shoulder of the bulb. Keep onions weed-free and well fertilized. For large onions plant them 4" apart.

Harvest scallions at any time through the season. For mature onions, break over the tops when they start to turn yellow. Later loosen the bulbs with a spading fork and let them dry in sun for a couple of days before storing by hanging or
